

Southeast Asia Incidents

1. (U) **KIDNAPPING UPDATE** – MALAYSIA: On 18 June, 10 fishermen from two Malaysian fishing vessels were kidnapped in Lahad Datu's Tambisan waters while en route to Semporna, Sabah. UPDATE: According to Malaysian and Philippine officials, Abu Sayyaf gunmen released the fishermen on 21 June after determining they were Bajau fishermen who had no money to pay for their ransom. Terms of Reference • (U) Attempted Boarding - Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat. • (U) High: 5 or mo

- (U) Boarding -Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel.
- (U) Fired Upon -Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel.
- (U) Hijacking Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement.
- (U) Kidnapping Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it.
- (U) Robbery Theft from a vessel or from persons a board the vessel.
- (U) Suspicious Approach All other unexplained activity in close proximity by an unknown vessel.

- (U) High: 5 or more piracy incidents in this one-week period.
- (U) Moderate: 2-4 piracy incidents in this one-week period.
- (U) Low: 0–1 piracy incidents in this one-week period.
