

Gulf of Guinea

- 1. (U) **SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY** NIGERIA: On 29 July, a supply vessel berthed at Onne port was approached by two people in a canoe. Duty officer saw the canoe and raised the alarm of which at that point the canoe moved away. No items were stolen. (www.csoalliance.com)
- 2. (U) **BOARDING** NIGERIA: On 25 July, ten robbers boarded a berthed bulk carrier during cargo operations near position 06:25N 003:20E, Berth No.TC09, Lagos. They assaulted and took hostage the duty crewman on routine rounds. The robbers stole ship's stores from the paint store room. They released the duty crewman and escaped in their boat. Alarm was raised, crew was mustered and a search was carried out. The crewman received minor injuries during the incident. Local authorities informed. (IMB)
- (U) A suspicious approach was reported this past week, with no further information available.

Horn of Africa Incidents

(U) No incidents to report.

Southeast Asia Incidents

- 3. (U) **BOARDING** INDONESIA: On 31 July, two robbers boarded an anchored bulk carrier near position 03:56N 098:48E, Belawan Anchorage. Alarm raised and crew mustered. Seeing the crew's alertness, the robbers escaped empty-handed. Incident reported to the port control. (IMB)
- 4. (U) **BOARDING** INDONESIA: On 31 July, six robbers armed with knives boarded a chemical tanker waiting for a pilot near position 06:01S 106:52E, 5 NM north of Tanjung Priok. They injured the chief engineer on routine rounds. Alarm raised and crew mustered. Seeing the crew's alertness, the robbers escaped empty-handed. Incident reported to local authorities. (IMB)
- (U) One boarding was reported this past week, with no further information available.

Terms of Reference	Piracy Levels
(U) Attempted Boarding - Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat.	• (U) High: 5 or more piracy incidents in this one-week period.
 (U) Boarding -Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel. 	• (U) Moderate: 2–4 piracy incidents in this one-week period.
 (U) Fired Upon -Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel. (U) Hijacking - Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement. (U) Kidnapping - Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it. 	• (U) Low: 0–1 piracy incidents in this one-week period.
 (U) Robbery - Theft from a vessel or from persons a board the vessel. (U) Suspicious Approach - All other unexplained activity in close proximity by an unknown vessel.
